Baseball/Softball Camp - Introduction to T-Ball (Age 3-4 with Parent/Guardian)

Encourage your child's athletic development alongside qualified caring staff. Parents/Guardians are required to participate with child. Coaches will instruct players and parents in the basic fundamentals of the sport. Batting, throwing, catching, and running bases will be introduced and practiced each session. Players will experience practice-like drills and games that will grow into scrimmage play. Each session will be informative, fun, and assist in the development of motor skills and the basic understanding of team sports. All participants will receive a team T-shirt. A ball glove is required, all other equipment will be provided. Rainouts will be made up through August 9 if needed. No camp July 2 through July 5.

Baseball/Softball Camp - T-Ball and Coach Pitch Level 2 (Ages 6 - 8)

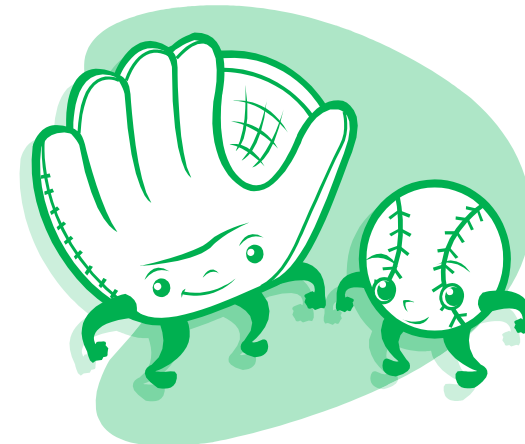
